1. Seeking directions to the official respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and promote him to the post of Forest Guard (Group-C) from the date when his juniors respondent(s) No.4 to 7 were considered and promoted, the instant petition has been filed.

2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 19.02.2025 (Annexure P-8) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.3- Divisional Forest Officer, Ambala, District Ambala (Haryana) is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 19.02.2025 (Annexure P-8) served by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Dr. (Ms.) Malvika Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. She, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 19.02.2025 (Annexure P-8) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
