1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a *mandamus* upon respondent no.2, to issue registration certificate of Pharmacist to the petitioner after adjudicating the application preferred by the petitioner on 18.01.2023 (Annexure P-8) .

2. On an advance notice, Mr. Gopal Sharma, Advocate, has caused appearance on behalf of respondent no.2, and informs this Court that the grievance of the present petitioner has already been redressed as he has been issued a registration certificate of pharmacist.



3. In view the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the grievance of the present petitioner, has already been redressed, therefore, the prayer, as made in the instant petition, has been rendered infructuous.

4. Consequently, the instant petition, stands **dismissed** as having been rendered infructuous.
