1. The instant petition under Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023 has been filed for issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 for taking appropriate action against private respondents No.4 and 5 or issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to act promptly and in accordance with law upon the representation dated 23.12.2024.
2. Already petitioner and private respondents are in civil litigation, as mentioned in Annexure P-1. Civil suit i.e. CIS-CS-912-2020 is already pending before the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division) Hoshiarpur.
3. By going through the representation, it is found that no action is required to be warranted on the basis of the same and petitioner can avail the remedy, whichever is available to him under the law before an appropriate forum.
3. Accordingly, petition is disposed of.
