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Applications are allowed as prayed for.

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1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that even the commutation of pension, which has been revised and granted from the date of retirement has not been done in accordance with law and nothing has come to the knowledge of the petitioners that as to how the rate of interest has been prescribed on the said amount so as to deduct a sum of Rs.10 lacs from the whole of the commuted amount for which amount, the petitioners are entitled for.

2. Learned counsel for petitioners further submits that the petitioners intend to approach the respondents by way of filing

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representation qua the said issue by asking for due explanation as to for what revised commutation of pension amount, the petitioners are entitled for and prays that the respondents be directed to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioners raising the grievance for fixation of commutation of pension upon revision of the pay scale w.e.f. 01.01.2006, appropriate speaking order upon the same will be passed by the respondents within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of such representation and in case, it is found that the valid objections are taken by the petitioners, the grievance of the petitioners will be redressed otherwise, due reasons after dealing with all the objections raised by the petitioners in their representation, will be given in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

5. Ordered accordingly.
