1. Instant petition has been filed *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents not to hold parallel enquiries on the applications given by the private respondents in case FIR No.0030, dated 05.04.2022, Annexure P-1, registered for offences under Sections 420, 406, 201, 120-B, IPC, at Police Station S.G.N.Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda.

2. Upon notice, replies have been filed on behalf of the official respondents as well as private respondents. In their response, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-2, Bathinda, states that on conclusion of investigation a final report under Section 173, Cr.P.C., has been presented before the Trial Court.



- 3. Counsel for the petitioner states that a protest petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is the complainant, which is pending.
- 4. In view of above development, no direction can be issued.
- 5. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to raise all the pleas before the Trial Magistrate.
- 6. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
