MANDEEP PANNU, J. (Oral)

1. With the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the main appeal is taken on Board for final disposal.
2. In compliance of order dated 05.08.2025 passed by this Court, both the parties have appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and as per report of the Mediator dated 08.08.2025, they have amicably settled the matter in the following terms:-

“a) Both the parties through their counsels have mutually agreed that respondent No.2-The New India Assurance Company would pay an amount of Rs.30,50,000/- (Rupees Thirty Lacs and Fifty Thousand only) over and above the amount Rs.8,41,547/- already awarded by the Ld. MACT, Gurdaspur.

b) The enhanced amount of Rs.30,50,000/- (Rupees Thirty Lacs and Fifty Thousand only) shall be



paid by the respondent No.2-The New India Assurance Company by way of cheque/draft in favour of appellant-Smt. Sukhwinder Kaur. The cheque/draft of Rs.30,50,000/- (Rupees Thirty Lacs and Fifty Thousand only) be issued in the name of Smt. Sukhwinder Kaur-appellant, within 30 (thirty) days and will be handed over by the counsel for the Insurance Company to the counsel for the appellant.

c) That the enhanced amount of Rs.30,50,000/- (Rupees Thirty Lacs and Fifty Thousand only) would be the full and final settlement and appellants will have no further claim against the respondents.”

3. Learned counsel for the parties have also admitted the factum of compromise in the afore-mentioned terms before this Court.

4. Accordingly, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the aforesaid amicable settlement between the parties.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
