1. These cases involve similar issues and therefore, are being disposed of together by this common order.
2. The prayer made in the present petitions is for regularization of services of the petitioners from the date of completion of 10 years of service.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that it is under the policy instructions dated 23.01.2001 that they would be covered and a similar case filed by one **Ajit Singh Vs. State of Punjab and Ors.**, CWP-2269-2016 was allowed on 23.08.2023 based on which, two writ petitions

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titled as **Bohar Singh Vs. State of Punjab and Ors.**, CWP-17175-2018 and **Sudagar Singh and Ors. Vs. State of Punjab and Ors.**, CWP-5325-2019 were disposed of on 16.04.2024. He prays that his case be considered keeping in view the aforesaid judgments in a time bound manner, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.

4. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, these petitions are hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners, taking note of the aforesaid judgments, within a period of 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
