KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a mandamus, upon the respondent No.2, to take immediate necessary action, on the complaint/representation dated 18.04.2022 (Annexure P-14), made by the petitioner.

2. At this stage, without observing anything on the merits of the representation (supra), preferred by the petitioner, this Court deems it fit and appropriate, to dispose of the instant writ petition, with a mandamus upon the respondent No.2, to decide the representation (supra), made by the petitioner, within a period of two months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order/judgment.



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- 3. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**.
- 4. It goes without saying that such a decision shall be taken by the respondent No.2, after affording an opportunity of hearing to all the necessary parties concerned.
- 5. Ordered accordingly.
