Prayer in the present writ petition is for seeking quashing of order dated 24.12.2015 (Annexure P-21) passed by respondent No.1 as well as order date 02.02.2016 (Annexure P-22) along with proceedings dated 21.12.2015 regarding item No.12 vide which the petitioner has been directed to vacate the site of petrol pump.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that he has no instructions in the matter.

On 05.12.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Affidavit of the petitioner has been filed today in Court wherein it has been averred that the petitioner shall clear the pending lease amount as per the erstwhile rate of rent @ 16000/- per month within a period of two months viz. till 04.02.2024. The affidavit is taken on record.

The issue involves determination of the rate of rent for the leased property. It has been informed that the petitioner has been in arrears even at the erstwhile rates and has been retaining possession of the said land.

Before proceeding in the matter any further, the petitioner is required to deposit the arrears as per his own undisputed admissions.

To come up on 18.03.2024.”

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that since he has no further instructions in the matter, therefore, he is not aware whether the petitioner has complied as per averments contained in his affidavit or not.

It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present writ petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
