1. This application has been filed under Order XXIII Rule 1 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 read with Rule 32 of the Writ Jurisdiction (Punjab & Haryana) Rules, 1976 seeking withdrawal of the main petition with liberty to file a fresh petition or to revive the same in case any cause survives.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that co-delinquent employees have already been exonerated by the respondents.

Further, the respondents have assured the applicant-petitioner to exonerate him in the disciplinary inquiry initiated vide chargesheets dated 13.03.2015 & 28.09.2015 (Annexures P-2 & P-3), if he withdraw the present petition.

3. In view of the above, instant application is allowed and the main petition, which is on regular board of this Court, is taken up today for final disposal.

4. Present civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* seeking quashing of the disciplinary inquiry initiated vide chargesheets dated 13.03.2015 & 28.09.2015 (Annexures P-2 & P-3), keeping in view the fact that the petitioner stands retired on 30.09.2015.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the respondents be directed to decide the disciplinary proceedings in a time bound manner.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.

7. However, the respondents are directed to conclude the disciplinary proceedings expeditiously preferably within a period of four months from today.
