In the present petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the period of daily wages service from 21.06.1991 to 01.04.1999 alongwith regular service as qualifying service for the purpose of grant of pensionary benefits.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.1 to decide the representation dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

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4. Mr. Sumit Kalyan, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and does not object to the prayer made by learned counse for the petitioner.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order, within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
