The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the speaking order dated 18.01.2025, Annexure P-10, whereby the petitioner's services for the post of Extension Lecturer (Chemistry) have been dispensed with on account of being ineligible, and she has been relieved from service vide letter dated 20.01.2025, Annexure P-11.

2. A perusal of the impugned order shows that despite petitioner's ineligibility, she was engaged as Extension Lecturer (Chemistry) at Rajiv Gandhi Government College for Women, Bhiwani, on 09.08.2014. It was due to non-availability of regular Assistant Professors and eligible Extension Lecturers at that time. However, even now, the petitioner does not fulfill the eligibility conditions, as she has neither cleared National Eligibility Test (NET) nor has she been awarded Ph.D. degree in the subject concerned. As per the policy for engaging Extension Lecturers in Government Colleges dated 04.03.2020 and amended instructions dated 14.12.2023, ineligible Extension Lecturers cannot be allowed to continue in service.



- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to dispute the facts aforementioned.
- 4. In view of the petitioner’s ineligibility for engagement as Extension Lecturer and stipulation in policy dated 04.03.2020, no exception can be taken to the impugned order dated 18.01.2025.
- 5. In view thereof, there is no ground to entertain the present petition and it stands dismissed *in limine*.
