The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for appointing a Warrant Officer to release the detinue, whose name is mentioned in Paragraph No.3 of the petition, from the illegal custody of respondents No.2 to 3.

As per report received from the Warrant Officer, the alleged detinue had been arrested on the intervening night of 30/31.05.2025 at 1.11 hours in case arising out of FIR No.41 dated 19.04.2025. A GDR is also stated to have been entered in this regard. Copy of the arrest information report has been tagged with the report of the Warrant Officer.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.
