The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari seeking quashing the action of respondents including the petitioners in On-line General Transfer Drive-2024 ignoring the fact that petitioners belongs to 'Dying Cadre' and accordingly they can not be considered in On-line General Transfer Drive, 2024.
