The prayer in this petition under Section 482 BNSS is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.263 dated 05.12.2024 under Sections 109, 132, 221, 121(1), 121(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS registered at P.S. Bhikhi, District Mansa.

On 10.06.2025 the following order was passed:-

“ *Contends, inter alia, that present FIR was registered on 05.12.2024; final report has already been presented on 27.03.2025 and petitioners are ready to join the proceedings before learned trial Court.*

Mr. Prit Inder Pal Singh, learned Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent; seeks time to have instructions and/or to file written response in



the matter.

Posted for 21.07.2025.

Meanwhile, petitioners shall join the proceedings before learned trial Court within three weeks from today and upon doing so, they be released on interim bail, in the present case, till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to its satisfaction.”

In deference to the aforementioned orders, the petitioners have appeared before the Trial court and have been granted bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, the petitioners shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and shall not absent themselves without any sufficient cause.
