1. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel are *ad idem* that the order dated 16.05.2023 (Annexure P-4), which is impugned before this Court, by filing the instant writ petition, as cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is appealable under the provisions of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has made a request to allow the petitioner to withdraw the instant petition, with liberty to approach the authorities concerned, for the relief, as sought in the instant writ petition.

3. The prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is not opposed by the learned State counsel. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **dismissed as withdrawn**, with the aforesaid liberty.

4. In case, the petitioner files an appeal before the authority concerned, within a period of one month, from the date of receipt of certified

delay, the authorities concerned shall consider the application of the petitioner sympathetically, specifically, in view of the fact that the petitioner has earlier opted to file a wrong motion before this Court.
