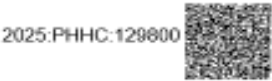

1. Through the instant petition prayer is made for issuance of mandamus to the respondents to deposit the amount in the respective Provident Fund account of the petitioners.

2. Mr. Rajesh Hooda, Advocate, who has caused appearance on behalf of respondents No. 2 & 3 informs this Court, that subsequent to the filing of the instant petition, the assessment proceedings were commenced, and consequently the assessment order was passed on dated 09.08.2018, and most of the assessed amount has been recovered i.e. out of Rs. 54,69,746/-, Rs. 2,56,138/- is yet to be recovered.

3. In view of the above specific stand of the learned counsel for respondents No.3 & 4, the asked for mandamus is not required to be passed.



- 4. The petition stands **disposed of** accordingly.
- 5. If the petitioners, still have any grievance they have liberty to approach the authority concerned at the first instance.
