The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.92 dated 30.04.2025 registered under Sections 109, 333, 115(2), 190, 191(3) of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.06.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.06.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
