The prayer in the present Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.5.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that in fact, there is a complaint filed by respondent No.5 against the son of the petitioner regarding a sum of Rs.34 lakhs having been paid to the son of petitioner to send the son of respondent No.5 abroad.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Needless to say, in case the petitioner is aggrieved by any act on the part of respondent No.5, he is free to avail remedies both under civil and criminal law.
