1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.91 dated 02.11.2023, under Section 420 of IPC and Section 10 of Emigration Act, (Sections 465, 468 and 471 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station, Qila Lal Singh, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no direct allegations against the petitioner in the FIR.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. K.D. Sachdeva, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and Mr. Vipin Mahajan, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the complainant and filed his Vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

5. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioner is the main accused and the amount had been deposited in his account. It is further submitted that as per account statement, the complainant had



deposited the disputed amount in the account of wife of the petitioner who immediately transferred the same in account of petitioner.

6. Learned State counsel contends that since the petitioner would be required for recovery of the disputed amount, thus, at this stage, he be not granted concession of anticipatory bail.

7. As per learned State counsel, the recovery of disputed amount is yet to be effected for which custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

8. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

9. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
