The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the order dated 21.08.2017 (Annexure P-13) vide which the respondents have superseded the petitioners for promotion to the post of Assistant Commandant (Transport).

Learned counsel for respondent/UOI has produced a copy of order dated 17.02.2025 asserting that all the petitioners have granted the promotion as has been detailed in a table, which reads as under:-

4	Insp. (MM)	Amar Singh	Case will be considered after availability of vacancy of SC category
5	Insp. (MM)	Ishwar Singh	Case will be considered after availability of vacancy of SC category
6	Insp. (MM)	Prem Shanker	Retired on superannuation on 30.11.2022
7	Insp. (MM)	Chander Singh	During the DPC-2024, his case was considered against ST vacancy, but assessed as UNFIT since promotional course not done by him
8	Insp. (MM)	Krishan Kumar	Promoted to the rank of AC(TPT) in the year 2023 and taken over charge of AC(TPT) on 21.09.2023
9	SM (MM)	Pawan Kumar	Promoted to the rank of AC(TPT) in the year 2023 and taken over charge of AC(TPT) on 16.11.2024
10	Insp. (MM)	Ram Singh	Promoted to the rank of AC(TPT) in the year 2024 and taken over charge of AC(TPT) on 06.02.2024. The officer has been retirede on superannuation on 31.12.2024

In the light of above, the prayer made in the instant petition stands addressed and no cause of action survives for continuation of the instant writ petition.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed off having been rendered infructuous.
