(4) Learned Addl.PP for UT, Chandigarh, after obtaining instructions from the quarter concerned, apprised the Court that in terms of the Standard Operating Procedure/Instructions dated 25.04.2025, issued by the Chandigarh Administration, Home Department, petitioners can approach the Authorities concerned on Mobile No.9915023456, Women and Child Helpline, Sector-19-B, Chandigarh.

(5) In view of the above, present petition is disposed off with liberty to petitioners to approach the quarter concerned.

(6) Needless to say that in case an occasion so arises, petitioners would be at liberty to avail the remedy as per law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
