1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of cross case of DDR No.21 dated 23.11.2019 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran in FIR No.0183 dated 20.11.2019 under Sections 307, 326, 323, 148 & 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-5)



alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P-6).

2. Vide order dated 19.02.2025, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Magistrate for getting their statements recorded with respect to the compromise dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P-6).

3. Pursuant to aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patti and got their statements recorded. Report dated 01.04.2025 has been received whereby after recording the statements of the parties, the Court below has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. I have heard counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

5. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court below and considering the offence for which the accused have been charged are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences for betterment of future life of the parties and also in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the present petition for quashing the FIR is allowed qua the petitioners.



6. Resultantly, cross case of DDR No.21 dated 23.11.2019 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran in FIR No.0183 dated 20.11.2019 under Sections 307, 326, 323, 148 & 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-5) alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
