As agreed, as per statement of learned counsel for the appellant (separately recorded) and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.8,00,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the LR's of appellant No.1 i.e. (i) Ramrati and (ii) Jai Bhagwan in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount is to be paid to LR's of the appellant i.e. (i) Ramrati and (ii) Jai Bhagwan, in equal share.

Accordingly, we dispose of the present appeal with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed-cheques for a total amount of Rs.8,00,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs Only) in the name of LR's of appellant No.1 i.e. (i) Ramrati and (ii) Jai Bhagwan in equal shares, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 08 weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 7% per annum shall follow on the above-said amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt, after receiving the cheque, to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
