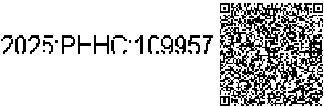

KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant writ petition, as cast under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a direction upon respondents No.2 and 3, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 6.

2. In compliance to the order dated 18.06.2025, passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, a status report on behalf of the official respondents has already been filed.

3. A perusal of the abovesaid status report reveals that since the dispute between the parties is civil in nature, therefore, the police cannot take any action. However, the Station House Officer, Police Station City-1, Abohar, has initiated proceedings under Section 126/169 BNSS, 2023, as a preventive measure vide DDR No.32, dated 03.07.2025 against private respondents, namely Kamaldeep Singh and Preet Kaur. Moreover, the Deputy Superintendent, Abohar (City) and Station House Officer, Police Station City-1, Abohar, have also been directed to ensure regular Beat Patrolling/Mobile Patrolling in the residential and



occupational area of the petitioner, to ensure her safety from any potential threat or intimidation, thereby alleviating her sense of fear.

4. In view of the above, this Court finds that the measures that have been resorted to, by the authorities, are adequate. Therefore, no further directions are required to be passed, at this stage.

5. However, in the event, the petitioner still apprehends any danger to her life and liberty, she is at liberty to approach the authorities concerned, who, after evaluating the threat perception, shall take necessary measures, in accordance with law.

6. Accordingly, the petition is **disposed of**.
