1. On 08.05.2023, the following order was passed:

“Learned State counsel on instructions submits that out of 13 petitioners, the petitioners No.1 to 4, 6 to 9 and 11 to 13 have already been granted regular promotion, therefore, the present petition i.e. CWP No.24105 of 2017 qua them has become infructuous.

This fact has been admitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of aforesaid position, CWP No.24105 of 2017 qua the petitioners No.1 to 4, 6 to 9 and 11 to 13 has become infructuous.

As regards the petitioners No.5 and 10, the learned State counsel seeks time to have proper instructions from the dealing officer.

Let the dealing officer of this case be present in the Court along with the relevant record on the next date of hearing.
