1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.10 dated 09.01.2025, registered under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 61(2) (Section 336(3) and 338 of BNS, 2023 added later on), at Police Station Ambala Cantt. District Ambala.
2. Reply dated 25.07.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof, has been supplied to counsel opposite.
3. Vide order dated 10.06.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that that the petitioner has joined investigation on 19.06.2025 and he is not required for custodial interrogation as recovery of amount of Rs.5,000/- has been effected from the petitioner.



5. Keeping in view of the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 10.06.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
