NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.87, dated 01.09.2015, registered under Sections 494, 406, 420, 380 IPC (Sections 497, 498, 506, 120-B, 420, 120-B IPC added lateron) at Police Station Satnampura, District Phagwara (Annexure P-1), on the basis of oral compromise entered into between the petitioner, co-accused and the complainant.

2. On 10.02.2025, the following order was passed:-

“Learned State counsel submits that the present petition filed through the SPA is not maintainable as the petitioner himself is available and it has wrongly been recorded in the order dated 17.09.2024 that he is presently residing abroad. He seeks time to file status report by attaching all the zimni

orders, whereby proclamation proceedings have been initiated against the petitioner.
Let the needful be done within a period of 03 weeks.
Adjourned to 30.04.2025.”

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action at an appropriate stage.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
