MANISHA BATRA, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.59 dated 16.06.2024, registered under Sections 306, 120-B of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Majitha Road, Amritsar.
2. Vide order dated 10.06.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that that the petitioner has joined investigation on 26.07.2025. She further submits that since the co-accused have not been arrested in this case and to know their whereabouts, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.
4. In the considered opinion of this Court, the reason given by learned State counsel for custodial interrogation of the petitioner, who has



already joined investigation, would not be a good ground to deny him the concession of pre-arrest bail.

4. Keeping in view of the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 10.06.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
