1. Prayer in the present petition has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.97 dated 20.05.2025 under Sections 336(2), 338, 340(2), 61(2) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana, Punjab.
2. Vide order dated 11.06.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 11.06.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Harjinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, District Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, in the Court today, same is taken on record. Learned State counsel, on



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instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

5. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 11.06.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S.

7. Petition stands allowed.
