1. Prayer in the present petition has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.255 dated 29.11.2024 under Sections 109, 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS, registered at Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.
2. Vide order dated 11.06.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 11.06.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Jaspal Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central, Amritsar has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, in the Court today and same is taken on record. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has

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joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has opposed the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 11.06.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S.

7. Petition stands allowed.
