1. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondents No.1 to 4 to recover detainee Barkha, who is in illegal custody of respondents No.5 to 8.

2. In compliance of the previous order, reply dated 30.06.2025 has been filed by the State by way of affidavit of Ms. Monica, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, NIT, Faridabad, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

3. Mr. Arjun Dhingra, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.5 to 8 and has filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record.

4. The petitioner before this Court is father of the detenu Barkha. This Court had directed to the parties to be present. Today, the detenu is present in the

Court and interacted with detenue Barkha, who stated that she is 20 years of age and had voluntarily married with Somesh i.e. respondent No.6 on 20.05.2025, who is also present in the Court. He submits that he is 25 years of age and both of them are now legally married.

5. In view of the facts and circumstances of the present case, no further order is required to be passed by this Court and the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail an alternative remedy as available to him in accordance with law.
