1. This petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, alleging wilful disobedience of order dated 07.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP-3613-2025.

2. Mr. Suneel Ranga, DAG, Haryana, puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent, on an advance copy of petition having been served upon him and submits that the revision petition (ROR No.290/2023-24) could not be finally disposed of for want of notice to the respondents. However, stay has been granted in favour of the petitioner vide order dated 03.07.2025, a certified copy whereof has been produced in Court and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof stands furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. After having gone through the aforesaid order, learned counsel



for the petitioner states that cause of action in the present petition does not survive and the same be disposed of as such.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the present contempt petition is disposed of.
