The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the transfer order, dated 04/05.06.2025, *qua* the petitioner who is working as Craft Instructor at GITI Gurugram.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before respondents. At this stage, petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide his pending representation, dated 28.05.2025, Annexure P-5, in a specified period. He has also relied upon the judgment dated 26.05.2025 in CWP-14733-2025 titled *Shyam Sunder Yadav and others v. State of Haryana and others* passed by this Court in case of similarly situated Storekeepers in the Department.

3. Notice of motion.



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4. Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that the pending representation, dated 28.05.2025, will be decided by respondent no.2/Director, Skill Development and Industrial Training by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, and in terms of *Shyam Sunder Yadav* case (*supra*) within a period of four weeks.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
