1. The challenge in this writ-petition is to the order passed by respondent No.2-Armed Forces Tribunal (for short 'the AFT') on 06.12.2022 (Annexure P-1).

2. Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioners had challenged the order dated 06.12.2022 by preferring a writ-petition in the year 2025 before this Court and no cogent reasons have come up for the inordinate delay in approaching this Court.

3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in "*Thirunagalingam vs. Lingeswaran and another*" 2025 INSC 672, has observed that delay should not be condoned merely on generosity and bonafides of explanation is necessary. Therefore, we would not accept the reasons coming forward for the inordinate delay.



4. In view thereto, the order passed by the AFT does not warrant any interference. The present writ-petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
