1. Petitioner Prem Kumar has filed petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 70 dated 16.03.2025 under Section 127(6) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (later deleted) and Section 137(2) and 96 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (added later on) (corresponding to Section 363 and 366A of IPC) registered at Police Station Dabwali, District Sirsa, Haryana.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that petitioner was arrested in this case on 02.04.2025. He was granted regular bail on 02.05.2025 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa (Annexure P-4). Challan was presented and trial was going on, when he failed to appear on 22.05.2025 (Annexure P-5), as a result, petitioner filed present petition seeking anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for petitioner referred to order dated 13.06.2025 and in pursuance of this, he appeared before the trial Court and filed application vide which he has been granted interim bail on furnishing

bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court and case is pending for prosecution evidence on 06.09.2025.

3. Learned counsel representing State has confirmed aforesaid factual position.

4. In the light of this, present petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court in pursuance of order dated 13.06.2025 and is facing trial. No purpose would be served by sending him behind the bars. Therefore, interim bail already granted by the Coordinate Bench vide order dated 13.06.2025 stands confirmed and petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
