This is an application under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for placing on record the medical record and other relevant documents pertaining to the ailment of the wife of the petitioner as Annexures P-3 to P-5.

For the reasons mentioned in the application as well as submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the same is allowed.

Annexures P-3 to P-5 are ordered to be taken on record with just exceptions.

This is a petition under Section 483 of B.N.S.S., 2023 with a humble prayer for extension of interim regular bail for a period of one month pending trial

to the petitioner in FIR No.368 dated 11.09.2024, under Section 109 (2), 115, 117(2), 3(5) and 351(2) of B.N.S., 2023, registered at Police Station Agroha, District Hisar, Haryana (Annexure P-1) as the condition of the wife and newly born baby of petitioner is not good and their treatment is going on.

Status report filed by way of an affidavit of Kishori Lal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Agroha, Hisar, is taken on record.

Perusal of the report dated 15.06.2025 at Annexure R-1 issued by Guru Jambheshwar Multispecialty Hospital and IVF Centre shows that the wife of the petitioner is currently experiencing post operative weakness and has been advised complete rest for a period of two weeks to aid proper recovery.

Be that as it may, considering the fact that there no other male member to look the wife of the petitioner and the newly born baby, who stands discharged from the hospital on 07.06.2025, this petition deserves to be accepted.

Accordingly, the interim bail earlier granted to the petitioner by the Trial Court vide order dated 04.06.2025, and subsequently extended till today i.e., 18.06.2025, is hereby further extended for a period of two weeks

The petitioner shall surrender back to the Jail Authorities on 02.07.2025 by 5 PM.

It is however made clear that no further extension would be granted.

The petition stands disposed off.
