LISA GILL, J.

1. Learned counsel for respondents no.1 to 3, at the outset submits that copy of order dated 20.03.2025 allotting the tender has been supplied to learned counsel for petitioner today itself, in Court and as far as complaints dated 07.05.2025 and 14.05.2025 are concerned, same shall be decided by competent authority, in accordance with law within a period of six weeks.
