SANJAY VASHISTH, J (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioners, namely Abhishek Singh, aged about 20 years, and Ms. Manisha, aged about 19 years, seeking directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty from the threat posed by the private respondents.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioners, being major, have solemnized their marriage on 02.06.2025, and in this regard, marriage certificate has also been issued by the Parmatam Valmit Dharm Parchar Committee (Annexure P-3).
3. It is further submitted that respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are residents of the State of Punjab, and respondent Nos.6 and 7, who are residents of the State of Uttar Pradesh, are unhappy with the marriage. Due to this, petitioners are feeling apprehensive about their safety and

have approached this Court by way of present petition, seeking protection.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On advance notice, Mr. Neeraj Madaan, Sr. DAG, Punjab, puts an appearance on behalf of the respondent/State, and on instructions from ASI Balwant Singh, submits that in fact, required statements of both the petitioners have already been recorded, and as per the said statements, as of now, there is no threat perception and petitioners do not require any protection.

6. At this stage, counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the present petition.

7. Accordingly, present petition stands disposed of, as the same being not pressed, at this stage.
