1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.PC for issuance of direction to official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.60 dated 09.06.2022 under Sections 406/420 of IPC, 1860 (Section 13 of the Punjab Travels Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 was added later on) registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar Rural, (Annexure P-1).

2. Short reply dated 12.02.2024 has already been filed by the State by way of affidavit of Mr. Sarwanjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Phillaur, Jalandhar Rural, which is taken on record.

3. At the very outset, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dilwara Singh submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed and the investigating

agency has already concluded the investigation and filed the final report under Section 173 Cr.PC before the jurisdictional Court. He further submits that respondent No.4 has been declared innocent. Therefore, the present petition has become rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
