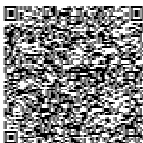
KIRTI SINGH, J. (Oral)

This petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India has been filed seeking direction to the official respondent(s) to protect the life & liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 24 (arrayed in the petition) and to take action on her representation dated 05.06.2025 (Annexure P2).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 05.06.2025 (Annexure P2) before respondent No.2 raising her grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and to take necessary action thereupon.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Served with an advance copy of the petition, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 05.06.2025 (Annexure P2) of the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
6. Needless to say, if any threat perception is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide her adequate security in order to protect her life and liberty.
