1. Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023, for setting aside the complaint dated 09.03.2022 alongwith Summoning order dated 31.10.2023 (Annexure P-15), passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, whereby, petitioners have been summoned to face trial for offences under Section 34, 35, 37 of Aadhar Card Act, 2016 read with Section 415, 416, 419, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC and Sections 66, 70 of IT Act

2. It has been pointed out by learned counsel for respondent No.2 that petitioners have not challenged the summoning order before the Revisional Court i.e. Court of Sessions, at the first instance and have directly approached this Court by way of present petition.

3. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of, by observing that in case, petitioners choose to file a revision petition before Court of Sessions within a period of one month from today, same would be

decided on merits by such Revisional Court without adhering to the delay part, if any, after examining the complete record, as per law, within a period of next three months, by providing adequate opportunity to all the concerned parties.
