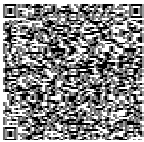

1. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case bearing FIR No.72 dated 20.04.2025 registered under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'NDPS Act') (Section 29 of NDPS added later on) at Police Station Kalka.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required in this case.
3. State counsel has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.
4. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated



16.06.2025 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
