SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3, with the following substantive prayer:

"It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that this petition may kindly be allowed and necessary directions be issued to respondents No. 2 & 3 to provide adequate protection to the petitioner, who is law abiding person and is apprehending danger to his life and liberty at the hands of respondents no. 04 to 26 and directions may also be issued to respondent no. 2 & 3 to restrain the respondents no.04 to 26 from harassing the petitioner in the interest of justice.

It is further prayed that any other relief which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be granted in the interest of justice, equity and fair play. "

2. Petitioner, who has appeared in person, through V.C., at this stage, limits his prayer and submits that he would be satisfied, for the *nonce*, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and take a conscious decision on the representation (Annexure P-1) made by him in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion, at this stage, to official respondents only.



4. On the strength of the advance notice, Mr. Ashish Bishnoi, DAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. He submits he has no objection in case the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, at this stage, is accepted.
5. I have heard the petitioner and have perused the paper-book with their assistance.
6. Keeping in view the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case & without going into merits thereof, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, District Nuh, Haryana (respondent No.2 herein) to look into the representation (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner; objectively consider the grievance(s) raised in the said representation & take ratiocinated decision thereupon after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioner, in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from today. Such decision be communicated to the petitioner within fifteen days of it being taken.
7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
