For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and delay of 30 days in filing the appeal is hereby condoned.

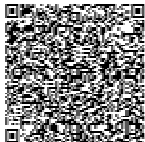

The present appeal has been preferred by the State of Haryana assailing order dated 29.05.2019 passed by the learned Single Bench in CWP-15464-2017 whereby the Court has allowed the Writ Petition granting the benefit of experience gained by the Writ Petitioner (respondent herein) while working with the State Government on contract basis from the year 2011 onwards for the purpose of granting him marks against the experience.

2. Heard learned State counsel at length.



3. It is to be noticed that respondent got 50.66 marks and was placed at No. 1 in the merit list. In view thereto, the directions issued by the learned Single Bench to the respondent-State to regularize the service of the respondent at par with other candidates, as reflected in documents therein, with all consequential benefits, does not warrant any interference by this Court. The Appeal is though time barred, but we condone the delay and dismiss the Appeal on merits accordingly.

4. All pending applications in this case are disposed of accordingly.
