The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.120, dated 28.06.2024, under Sections 324,323,379,342,506,148,149 of IPC, offence under Sections 326,325 of IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Guruharshai, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and the petitioners have joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel has opposed the bail and submits that there are serious allegations levelled against the petitioners.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant submits that the petitioners have amicably resolved all their

disputes with the complainant and he has no objection, in case the present petition is allowed.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 27.08.2024 is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
