VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J. (Oral):

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the patients, doctors and staff of Sukhmani Super Specialty Hospital, Ferozepur Road, Zira at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7, who were forcibly sitting on a *dharna* and were threatening the doctors, staff and patients from entering into the said hospital.

2. After notice of motion having been issued, status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Zira, District Ferozepur, has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. It has been averred that no fact as regards threats to the petitioner came to light during enquiry. Further, respondents No.6 and 7 gave statements that they had no personal grudge with the petitioner nor had they threatened him. It has further been mentioned that the Station House Officer, Police Station City Zira, has been directed to ensure about the safety of the petitioner either himself or through PCR/Duty Officer.

3. Learned State counsel submits that as of today, no *dharna* is being held and in future, if any, such act is committed by respondents No.6 and 7 or any other persons, at their instance, appropriate action, in accordance with law, shall be taken.

4. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed at this stage, and the present petition is accordingly disposed of.
