SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in a case arising out of FIR No.53 dated 30.04.2025 under Sections 18 and 29 of NDPS Act, Police Station City Samana, District Patiala.

2. Vide order dated 16.06.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating/Arresting Officer. The petitioner was also directed to cooperate with the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

3. Learned State Counsel has filed reply. The same be taken on record.

4. On the instructions of ASI Satpal Singh, Police Station City Samana, who is present in Court, learned State Counsel has stated that in



compliance with the order dated 16.06.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He has further stated that the presence of petitioner is not required for the investigation of the present case.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby allowed and the order dated 16.06.2025 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

Present petition stand disposed off, accordingly.
