This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, whereby the petitioners pray for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondents No.2 & 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 & 5.

2 The petitioners are run away couple and claimed to have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 & 5, who happen to be the father and uncle of petitioner No.1

3 Notice of motion.

4 Mr. Sandeep Vashisht, APP, UT, Chandigarh, who is present in Court on advance copy, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. He submits that after the representation submitted by the petitioners on 10.06.2025, the statement of petitioner No.1 was recorded on 16.06.2025, wherein she has stated that she apprehends no threat from respondents No.4



& 5. The statement in original has been produced by the learned APP, which is taken on record as **Mark ‘X’**.

5 In view thereof, this Court finds that the present petition is totally misconceived and deserves to be dismissed.
