SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents nos. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent nos.4 to 7.

Learned State counsel submits that a speaking order dated 17.06.2025 has been passed on the representation submitted by the petitioner. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the order read as under:-

“Keeping in view the abovementioned facts and statement of Daljit Singh, duly counter signed by Palwinder Kaur, no further action is required on the complaint of the complainants and the said complaint is being filed to record room. Copy of this speaking order is being provided free of cost to complainants. In case of dissatisfaction with these speaking orders, Complainants can appeal against these orders

*within 3 days from the date of receiving copy of these orders before
DSP Crime against women (CAW) Ferozepur”*

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for
withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail alternate remedy
by way of appeal as per notification No.HOME-HM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63
dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government
of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).

Dismissed as withdrawn.
